

## Internal Medicine/ Pediatrics Curriculum

Note: GRMEP is considering changing from a monthly schedule to a 13 4-week block schedule starting in 2012. Intern year for Med/Peds would be completed after the 13<sup>th</sup> block.

### PGY 1:

- Rotations between Internal Medicine and Pediatrics occur every 3 months to limit the total number of changes and to preserve continuity between each discipline.
- Intern year lasts 12 months

### PGY 2-4:

- Considered a senior level resident
- Rotate every 3-5 months
- Staggered pattern allows for the seasonal variation expected with inpatient Pediatrics (RSV bronchiolitis)
- Year will consist of 6 months of Internal Medicine and 6 months of Pediatrics

  - 1 pediatric elective month is call free
  - 1 requires cross coverage for pediatric floors, or newborn nursery

  - 2 weeks as Night Float\*

- ❖ Pediatric Hematology/Oncology – 2 weeks inpatient/ 2 weeks outpatient
- ❖ Pediatric Intensive Care Unit\*

- ❖ Swing Shift/Night Float Senior resident\*
  - 2 weeks of Swing Shift 4pm-1am

➤ Continuity Clinic

- ❖ 1 half day per week of Internal Medicine clinic per week
  - 4 – 7 patients
- ❖ 1 half day per week of Pediatric clinic per week
  - 6-10 patients
- ❖ Med/Peds attending physicians help staff both IM and Peds clinics
- ❖ Separate clinics allow our program to:
  - See equal numbers of Internal Medicine and Pediatric patients as required by the RRC
  - Allow cancellation of clinic during that are time intensive or are procedure heavy (as denoted by the \*)
  - Allow time with categorical Internal Medicine and Pediatric residents and attending physicians
  - Allow for more time in clinic for a more well rounded clinical experience
